- 5 I look for the Lord; my soul doth wait for him *
in his word is my trust.
- 6 My soul fleeth unto the Lord *
before the morning watch, I say, before the morning watch.

[This level of trust is one everybody should imitate.]

- 7 O Israel, trust in the Lord, for with the Lord there is mercy *
and with him is plenteous redemption.
- 8 And he shall redeem Israel *
from all his sins.
