No. 19 Blessed be the Name of the Lord [Double choir]

[“Moderately fast. Very strong and bright”]
[This sentence is heard three times each in the two choirs.]

Blessed be the Name of the Lord, henceforth and forevermore.

No. 20 Glory to the Father

[“Majestically”]
Amin.
Amen.
Slava Ottsu i Sinu i Duhu,
Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit,
Nine i priso i vo veki vekov. Amin.
Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Ghospodi, pomiluy. [sung 3 times in quick succession]
Lord, have mercy.
Blagoslovi.
Father, bless.

[The next 4 lines are chanted on one chord:]
Sviateyshiya patriarchi pravoslavnija,
The most holy Orthodox Patriarchs,
Preosviashchenniya mitropoliti,
The most reverend metropolitans,

And all Orthodox Christians,

[Returns to singing for the final text of the Liturgy; basses ending on a low B-flat.]
