[Some suggest the following lines refer to the Calvinist city council expelling the poet-minister from Amberg because he was Lutheran:]

[He later adds a pause before 'falscher Lehr' for emphasis.]

Behüt mich, Herr, vor falscher Lehr',

Guard me, Lord, from false teaching,

Des Satans Mord und Lügen wehr,

Defend me from Satan's murder and lies,

In allem Kreuz erhalte mich,

Sustain me in every affliction [cross].

Auf daß ich's trag' geduldiglich!

So that I may endure with patience!

[Brief instrumental interlude]

Herr Jesu Christ,

Lord Jesus Christ,

Mein Herr und Gott, mein Herr und Gott,

My Lord and God, my Lord and God,

[Faster, in triple meter]

Tröst mir mein' Seel' in Todesnot!

Comfort my soul in death's distress.

[Closing words to our theme song:]

O! dass diess jeder Sünder wüsste,

O! that every sinner would know this,

Sein Herz wohl bald dich lieben müsste.

His heart must soon surely love You.
